

2016-2017 RRISD Recommended Beginner Band Instruments Cedar Valley Middle School Edition

The appropriate instrument choice, including brand, model, mouthpiece and accessories, is crucial for your child's success and enjoyment. This recommended list is based on an extensive comparison of available beginner instruments by the specialists on the RRISD band staff, with special consideration of affordability, ease of playing, tone, pitch, and durability.

We ask that do not accept any substitutions of mouthpieces or accessories from this list from dealers without consulting with your child's band teacher. Please keep all receipts in the event that some item or accessory might need to be returned.

ALL Students:

- *Standards of Excellence Book 1 and 2* for your instrument UNLESS you are chosen to play percussion.
- Pocket Metronome – **Korg TM 50** Tuner with clip on contact microphone OR **Tonal Energy/Cleartune** app installed on phone with clip on microphone & **Peterson** adapter cable.
- Folding Music Stand
- Black 1.5 inch binder with pencil pouch, page protectors and six mechanical pencils

ALL Woodwind Students:

- Swabs for woodwind instruments (silk preferred - lasts longer and does not get stuck in instrument)
- Tuning rod for flute
- One box of **Vandoren** 2.5 reeds for clarinets and saxophones, 3 medium-soft reeds for oboes and bassoons
- **Rico** reed case for clarinets and saxophones
- **Hodge** reed case for oboes and bassoons reed, to hold at least two or three working reeds
- Thumb rest cushion for oboes and clarinets
- **Runyon/Vandoren** teeth and mouthpiece saver for clarinets and saxophones
- Neck strap for alto saxophones and clarinets
- Cork grease (not needed for flutes)

ALL Brass Students:

- BERP
- Mouthpiece brush, cleaning snake, polish cloth
- **Blue Juice** valve oil (piston valve) and **Holton** rotary oil /**Schilke** tuning slide grease/ **Trombonetine** slide cream and spray bottle for trombones

ALL Percussion Students: you will receive book/supply list through email when all band placements are done
